Our Commitment to Your Privacy:

The only time 3ABF will ask for your personal information is when you give a financial donation either online or offline via US Mail. During the donation process, we ask for your name, address, city, state, zip code. Personal information given to 3ABF will be used only for the intended purposes specified by the donor.

How You Can Access or Correct Your Information:

Errors can be corrected in your personal information by sending us a request that shows an error. To protect your privacy and security, we will also take reasonable steps to verify your identity before making corrections.

No information shall be released, either over the phone or in person, regarding the contact name and/or any other details about a donor, which they do not want released.
